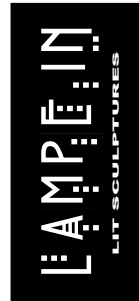

LIT SCULPTURES

Fifth-generation builder, Robin Hawke, has turned her considerable skills to sculpting. Enthralled by the raw qualities of rusted metal, she has begun building tall, strong, sculptural slabs of found metals, weaving in the elements of movement and light. Dynamic forms glow with light that enriches the finished metal surfaces and bounces off nearby walls to enhance whatever space they occupy.

The sculptor has paired with Valery Guignon, long-time fiber artist and lamp designer, to incorporate textures and materials that contrast with the found steel forms. The partnership results in an energetic approach to artistic lighting, sculptural pieces that are as delightful to look at unlit as when they cast their warming glow.

RELATIONSHIPS

This unique piece, designed to bounce light off the corners of a room, is a patchwork quilt of found steel welded onto a steel spring for flexibility. Four lights were mounted behind openings cut in the quilt and bent brass screening shades were slipped in place. The result is a stunning sculpture and a powerfully warming light when lit.

VENUS

Contrasting forms of steel energize this piece. A steel cylinder rises up to support an almost female shape of patched pieces of sheet steel. Cascading across the surface of the piece are light-catching holes resembling a star shower. Soft light glows from behind, enhancing the flowing upper forms of finished steel panels.

ELEMENTS

Three simple pieces of rusted sheet metal begin the piece. Details of pencil rod steel lines, brass mesh screen light shades and a spring coil steel base bring it to its completed harmony, an ode to the majesty of nature.
